

WHAT TO DO AFTER

Document the quality of your life as you are experiencing it **after** the Antelope Ridge Wind Facility has been built and is on line.

- Videotape your views and the natural sounds and noise levels that are normal for your area. Do this at various times of the day and season. Show how the flicker affects the rooms in your house throughout the day. Use a camera that will show the date and time of recording.
- Document your TV, cordless phone and cell reception.
- If your water source is from a well, have it re-tested for quality and quantity by a reputable source.
- If you live in the city limits, request a water test be done after the ARWF has been built and obtain a copy of new test. Contamination is a serious issue with construction and the use of herbicides.
- Have your property assessed post-development of the wind facility by a licensed and state-certified appraiser. If numerous neighbors request appraisals, a discounted fee may be able to be negotiated. The appraiser's testimony in court may be useful post-wind development.
- Take pictures of the road conditions in the community after the construction of the ARWF. Wind developers need to repair the damage they have done to county/city roads as a result of the construction.
- Solicit neighbors to share the expense of having a professional company monitor and record the noise levels at numerous times of day, night and season.
- If your business is dependent on sightseers, hunters, campers, etc., document average daily customers. Document any changes in business and revenue.
- Document the birds and wildlife that frequent the area with a camera and/or video that will imprint the date and time.
- Document any behavioral and/or physical changes in your pets and farm animals with a camera and/or video that will imprint the date and time. Should there be significant symptoms, have a veterinarian examine and document symptoms.
- Document any damage to your property due to wildlife, as they will be displaced into the valley.
- Farmers and landowners document amount and cost of noxious weed control used post-development of the wind facility and change in costs of application. There may be aerial spraying limitations.
- Document any negative health effects (see Health Record attached) and request an affidavit (see Health Affidavit attached) from your physician of any post-conditions that you or other family members may be suffering from as a result of the ARWF.
